Kia ora Ms Ardern,

Call for New Zealand to reject outright the so-called "deal of the century"

The Palestine Solidarity Network Aotearoa is calling on your government to reject outright the proposed "deal of the century" announced by US President Donald Trump last week.

This proposal claims to promote peace but is a recipe for ongoing conflict and further brutal oppression of Palestinians.

Among other things the US proposes to

- Accept illegal Israeli settlements on Palestinian land
- Approve Israel annexing (stealing) most of the occupied West Bank for itself
- Approve the ongoing military occupation of Palestinian land and the siege of Gaza
- Refuse Palestinian refugees the right to return to their land and homes
- Approve the on-going ethnic and religious cleansing of Jerusalem

For the Palestinian side there is nothing aside from a vague reference to a hollowed out Palestinian state sometime in the future which would resemble apartheid South Africa's bantustans. As the Israeli human rights group B'Tselem says: "The deal is like Swiss Cheese – the Israelis get the cheese while the Palestinians get the holes."

It is important to understand that this proposal rides roughshod over 70 years of United Nations resolutions and thumbs its nose at international law.

New Zealand supports the United Nations as a forum for the resolution of disputes and the use of international law to ensure, for example, that it is illegal to take and occupy land by force as Israel has done for 52 years.

The US proposal is not a negotiated settlement. It is an attempt to force an illegal and unjust "solution" onto the long-suffering people of Palestine. It has no moral, ethical or legal standing. It must be rejected outright.

New Zealand has a significant history of standing up for justice, human rights, international law and United Nations interventions. Our voice is needed now on this issue more than ever before. We urge you to speak out on behalf of the people of New Zealand.

Silence means complicity.

We look forward to hearing from you.

International Criminal Court decides to investigate Israeli war crimes

This was a welcome announcement in late December. After five years of preliminary investigation the ICC has decided to begin the process of opening a formal investigation into Israeli war crimes.

This also makes it very important that New Zealand war crimes investigator Julie Webb-Pullman gain New Zealand government assistance to re-enter Gaza to continue her work training Palestinians in the gathering of evidence of war crimes.

We reported in December that she had been refused New Zealand consular assistance to do this but she has reapplied and is waiting to hear back. In the meantime she is continuing her work online with the Gaza Centre for Human Rights.

We are working to help tertiary students revamp and reorganise local "Students for Justice in Palestine" groups around the country where these are no longer active.




Brother Peter Bray's visit to New Zealand



Victoria University: Shut Down Unethical Israeli Prize

Why is this important?

Victoria University of Wellington has refused to remove an essay prize funded by the Apartheid government of Israel. The prize is insulting to the university's own Palestinian students who have been forced from their homeland by the Israeli government. The Embassy of Israel Prize of \$250 is awarded to one student per year on the merit of an essay on one of the given topics - including "Israel in the Middle East", "Israel's bilateral relations with its neighbours", and "Israel's democracy in the context of the Middle East".

This prize is unethical because the Israeli government is guilty of building illegal settlements in Palestinian territory, preventing the flow of essential resources, and denying Palestinians the right to vote. It is a regime akin to Apartheid South Africa.

Petition to stop global tourism sites from profiteering from stolen Palestinian Lands

There is currently a petition from Amnesty International NZ calling on Trip Advisor to stop profiting from illegal Israeli settlements. The target in 1000 signatories, let us help them achieve this!
